



Toronto DRIE Scholarship

The Toronto chapter of the Disaster Recovery Information Exchange association wishes to announce its second annual scholarship program. There will be maximum of two- \$1000 scholarships that will be presented to active students from a Canadian institution and is working towards a degree or a certificate program. The scholarship is to be used for tuition fees, basic living costs and/or study materials (text books and equipment).

The selection process will be conducted by the Selection Committee of DRIE-Toronto based on the criteria of a) Performance and Attitude b) Need and c) Involvement within the Industry.

The Selection Committee will require the following from each applicant:

1. Certificate of enrollment from a Canadian College or University in a field of study including: Business Continuity, Emergency Management or Public Safety
2. A statement of academic standing
3. Provide statement of community and/or work involvement within the Business Continuity, Emergency Management and/or Public Safety industry. References are required.
4. Consent that DRIE may share information and images about the grant presentation.
5. Submission of a signed Application form on or before May 20, 2012

Incomplete or late application packet submissions will not be considered.
