



DRIE Scholarship

The Disaster Recovery Information Exchange is pleased to announce its 2013 scholarship program. There will be a maximum of two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to active students from Canadian institutions who are working towards a degree or a certificate program in Business Continuity, Emergency Management or Public Safety. The scholarships are to be used for tuition fees, basic living costs and/or study materials (text books and equipment).

The selection process will be conducted by an impartial Selection Committee of DRIE-Toronto, based on the criteria of:

- a) Performance and Attitude
- b) Need
- c) Involvement within the industry

The Selection Committee will require all of the following from each applicant:

1. Certificate of enrollment from a Canadian College or University in a field of study including: Business Continuity, Emergency Management or Public Safety
2. Statement of academic standing
3. Statement of community and/or work involvement within the Business Continuity, Emergency Management, or Public Safety industries. 2 references are required.
4. Consent that DRIE may share information and images about the grant presentation.
5. Submission of a signed application form and supporting information to be received no later than **May 17, 2013**. Incomplete or late submissions will not be considered.
